Micheal Paul Pry, 22, Topeka, passed away Friday, October 23, 2015, at his home from complications with cystic fibrosis.

Micheal was born September 2, 1993, the son of Tim and Paula Pry. Micheal graduated in 2012 from Washburn Rural High School. He underwent double lung transplant surgery at Duke Hospital in North Carolina in 2013 but developed infections and complications afterwards. He has fought an uphill battle his whole life and has shown us all how to be strong. He is loved and will be missed by all who knew him.

Micheal's survivors include his parents; sister, Misty Pry; and brother, Bodhi Pry; nephew, Maxwell Graf; grandparents, Dana and Janet Carter, Topeka; Susan and Gary Wilson, Joplin MO, Lou Pry, Jennings OK; and many aunts, uncles and cousins. He was preceded in death by his grandfather, Ralph Pry and recently by his brother, Matthew Pry.
