Mildred Bernice Frantzen, 91, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Monday, August 24, 2015.

Mildred was born January 7, 1924, in Slater, Iowa, the daughter of Thomas and Celia Heggam Skola. She graduated from Shipley High School in 1942. Mildred worked as an operator for Northwestern Bell from 1941-1945. On May 16, 1945, Mildred and Karl Herman Frantzen were united in marriage in Ames, Iowa. They celebrated 70 years together. The couple then moved to Spirit Lake IA until 1947, when they returned to Ames for Karl to finish his degree at Iowa State University in 1949 and stayed there until 1953. At that time they moved to Webster City where they remained until 1961, when they relocated to Omaha NE until 2014. At that time they moved to Topeka KS to be nearer their family.

Mildred was a wonderful homemaker. She was a good cook, enjoyed sewing and had a green thumb. Her presence will be missed.

She leaves to cherish her memory her husband, Karl; children, Sharon Lee Bennet, Jeffrey Alan Frantzen and Kurt Anthony Frantzen; eight grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by an infant son and all her siblings.
