Robert Michael Montgomery, Jr., age 88, of Topeka, passed away December 31, 2006 at his home. Robert was born April 30, 1918 in Axtell, Kansas, the son of Robert Michael and Julia Shaughnessy Montgomery, Sr. He worked for Morells Meat Packing Plant, then 29 years for Goodyear Tire & Rubber Co. as a machinist. He is founder of Montgomery Door Closer Service begun in 1943. He was a volunteer at St Francis as a Eucharistic Minister and the VA Hospital Chaplain services. He was a member of Most Pure Heart of Mary Catholic Church a nighttime guardian of the adoration chapel and a member of Knights of Columbus. He was a member of Strato Jet Square Dance Club, Golden Spokes Antique Car Club and Antique Auto Club of America. Robert married Mary Ann Broxterman, she preceded him in death in 1944. Bob married Marcella Spitz of Baileyville, June 14, 1947 at Holy Name Church. She survives.
