Nancy L. Redd, 85, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Friday, March 29, 2024.

Nancy was born May 15, 1938, in Topeka, the daughter of Ralph and Bessie Kasselhut Hockett. On July 1, 1961, Nancy and Larry Redd were married at Assumption Catholic Church, enjoying more than 62 years together prior to his death on November 20, 2023.
