Noah Thomas Lawler, aged 19, of Topeka, Kansas, passed away Saturday, July 27, 2024, as a result of a motorcycle accident. He was born on July 27, 2005, in Germantown, Tennessee, the beloved son of Kenneth and Laura Johnson Lawler.

Noah was actively involved in Blue Thunder Wrestling, Blue Thunder Football and Lawrence Elite Wrestling during his youth. He also played baseball at the Ken Berry Complex and later became an umpire there. Noah attended Washburn Rural High School, where he participated in wrestling and sang in the choir. After completing his junior year at Washburn Rural, he graduated from Topeka West High School in 2022.

Noah was free-spirited and loved adventure. After graduation, he modified a shuttle bus to travel around the country, showcasing his adventurous spirit. His love for snowboarding led him to move to Colorado for the ski season, where he skied over 100 days during that period. Upon returning to Topeka, he started Topeka Tint Co. with his cousin Nathan Mikoleit and friends John Cantrell and Sean Brown. Noah also enjoyed working on cars and riding motorcycles, activities that fueled his adventurous nature, and spending time with his dog, Jax.

Noah is survived by his loving parents, Ken and Laura Lawler; his siblings, Trace Lawler (Topeka), Trisha (Lawler) Pena, (Maryville TN), Kendra Lawler (Millington TN), and Keith Lawler (Millington TN); his grandparents, Karen Johnson (Topeka), and John and Mary Lawler (Covington TN); as well as nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, and cousins who cherished him dearly. He was preceded in death by his grandfather, Wesley Johnson.

Visitation will be Thursday, August 1, from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m. at Grace Point Church. Funeral service will follow at 7 p.m. at the Church.
