Nolan Paul Landry passed away Monday, 9 April, 2018.

Paul, as he was known to many, was born 21 December, 1926, near Paincourtville, Louisiana. He was the son of Aldes J. Landry and Ada Simoneaux Landry. Paul was raised on a southern Louisiana sugar cane plantation, but came to Topeka in 1951 with the USAF. This is where he met the love of his life, Delores Eagan Landry. Dee and Paul were married in Assumption Catholic Church on 26 July, 1952. They remained in Topeka and were married for nearly 65 years, until Delores passed away in June 2017.

Paul was employed as a carpenter for several years before going to work for the City of Topeka as Plans Checker and Building Inspector. He worked major projects during his career such as the Frito Lay Plant, the Blue Cross building and West Ride Mall along with countless others.

Paul and Dee have three sons, Donald, Matthew and Ted. Matthew passed away suddenly, 2 August 2014. Paul was also preceded in death by his parents and two siblings, Lloyd Landry (1925-2004) and Irene Landry (1928-1996).

Visitation will be Saturday, 14 April from 11:30 to 12:30. His funeral service follows at 12:30; both will be held at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home,
