We both have that "Reinhart" gene. Then there was the battle of the best basketball team. Knowing your mom loved basketball, and after an NCAA run for UD, I sent your mom UD Flyer goodies. Well your mom wasn't having that, and she tried to convert me to be a Kansas Jayhawks fan! I will always root for the Jayhawks (until they play the Flyers!), in her honor. She recently sent a beautiful crystal rosary to me and my daughter. She said that she and Debbie had the same one and she wanted me and my daughter to have one as well. I will always cherish that rosary, and all it means to me. My last memory was a phone call we shared just last week. I could hear in

her voice she was tired, and I knew she missed her son, Steve. Although she screened her calls, she still wanted to talk with me. She still cared about how I was feeling, even though she was feeling so poorly. That is who your mom is.....a love, warm, caring, wonderful, beautiful inside and outside, person. She will always have a special place in my heart. I love her and will miss her dearly. Heaven has a new Angel.
