Patrick J. Reilly, 92, Topeka, died Saturday, December 10, 2005.

Mr. Reilly was born February 9, 1913 in Newkirk, Oklahoma, the son of John and Katherine Shaughnessy Reilly. He graduated from Tonavay High School and came to Topeka in the summer of 1934 to work at St. Francis Hospital. He was a foreman at Morrell's from 1939 until the flood in 1951 which closed the plant. He was a foreman at Hills when he became a real estate broker. Pat was a rancher and real estate broker, holding his broker's license for 45 years. He was a member of Holy Name Church, Fourth Degree member of the Knights of Columbus, Council 534, and served on the Real Estate Board. On Thanksgiving Day, 1938 Pat and Margaret Hoferer were married. She survives at the home.

Other survivors include, three children, Jim Reilly and his wife, Sandy, Wichita, Larry Reilly and his wife, Marceta, Hoyt, and Marcie Holtz and her husband, Rob, Topeka; eight grandchildren, four of whom live in Topeka, Sarah, Lindsay, Michael, and Abbey Holtz; and eight great-grandchildren.

Mr. Reilly will lie in state and family will greet friends from 5 to 7 p.m. Monday, at Holy Name Church, where a parish rosary will be prayed at 6 p.m. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 1 p.m. on Tuesday at the church. Burial will follow at Mount Calvary Cemetery. Memorial contributions are suggested
