Paul Eakes, 84, of Topeka, passed away peacefully with his family at his side, on Thursday, October 31, 2013. Paul was born June 13, 1929, in Topeka KS, one of thirteen children of Casper and Mary Ann (Kaberline) Eakes. He grew up in Topeka and attended Sacred Heart Grade School and Hayden High School. He married Patricia Luksa on September 9, 1950. She survives of the home. Paul entered the army and was sent to Germany during the Korean Conflict. Paul got a job with the Santa Fe railroad as a painter and spent the next 41 years at that job. He was a very family oriented man who loved his children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. He spent much of his free time out of doors golfing and fishing and in later years spent time travelling with his wife and wintering in Tucson AZ. He and his wife were avid water skiers even up to age 80. Paul was a loyal member of VFW Post#1650 here in Topeka and was a member of their funeral detail, a job he prided himself in and enjoyed doing. Surviving Paul are his children, Paula Jacobs (Tom), Tucson AZ, Pam Wendt, Topeka KS, Brad Eakes (Connie), Topeka KS; six grandchildren; two great grandchildren; one brother and five sisters. Preceding Paul in death were his parents, four brothers and two sisters.
