February 10, 1939 - February 8, 2005

Paul William Hesse, 65, Topeka, died of heart disease on Tuesday, February 8, 2005 at his home.

He was born February 10, 1939 at Newbury KS, the son of Nicholas Herman and Adelia Catherine Gros Hesse. He was graduated from Flush High School where he played basketball. He was in the U.S. Navy from 1957 to 1961 and served in Guam and Japan. Paul was a self-employed contractor.

He married Winnie Northrop January 29, 1966 at Assumption Church. She died December 15, 1994. He married Twylla Piatt September 3, 2001, at Holy Name Church. She survives.

He was father to Stacey Rabe, Topeka, Christopher David Hesse, who died April 12, 1992, Jennifer Turner, Topeka, Catherine Hesse, New York NY, Margaret Hesse, Emporia, Ken Welborn, Meridian ID, and Nancy McGilvray, Caldwell ID.

He is also survived by four brothers, Fr. Mr. Hesse was a member of Holy Name Parish where he served on the Parish Council. He was instrumental in organizing the "Winnie Hesse Run For the Heart".

Mr. Hesse will lie in state from 5 to 8 and family will greet friends from 6 to 8 Friday at Assumption Church, 204 W. 8th st., Topeka, where a parish rosary will be prayed at 7:00 p.m. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 1:00 p.m. Saturday at Holy Name Church, 1114 W. 10th St., Topeka. Burial will follow at St. Joseph's Cemetery in Flush KS.
