Paul Ronald Kemble, 92, Dover, passed away January 20, 2016, peacefully at home.

Paul was born October 28, 1923, the son of Charles and Agnes Sherretts Kemble in Valencia KS. Paul was a WWII veteran, serving as a machinist mate second class on the USS South Dakota. He served in the United States Navy from 1943-1946. Following the war, Paul owned and operated Kemble Brothers Trucking with his brother "Short" for 20 years. The years following, until retirement, Paul worked for Drywall Construction owned by his brother Allen Dale.

Paul was a 4H leader and volunteer for 55 years. He was a 62 year member of the Masonic Lodge #138 and the American Legion in Dover.

Paul married Clydeen Patterson on October 30, 1948. Six daughters were born from this union.

Paul is survived by his daughters, Kathy Neeland, Judy Downey (Dennis), Connie Lynch (Mark), Ronda Harmon (Bob), Freda Lohse (Jeff), Dawn Brown (Michael); 17 grandchildren; 14 great-grandchildren; brother, Allen Dale Kemble (Pat). He was preceded in death by his wife, Clydeen; sister, Maude Dagg; brothers, Bill and Roy "Short" Kemble; son-in-law, Ralph Neeland.
