Paul G. Kreipe, 81, passed away Tuesday, September 15, 2009. Paul was born December 25, 1927 in Tecumseh the son of Gerald and Grace Bleskie Kreipe. He attended Sacred Heart Grade School and Capital Catholic (Hayden) High School. He served in the Marine Corps for two years and was honorably discharged in 1948.
