Paul William Ogle, 89, Topeka, passed away at his home Sunday, March 20, 2016.

Paul was born December 17, 1926, in Topeka, the son of William and Bertha Stolte Ogle. Paul was in the first graduating class of Holy Name Grade School. He is a 1945 graduate of Capitol Catholic High School. Paul began working for Adams Business Forms in 1943 while still in high school. He left for two years while serving our country in the US Army and returned until his retirement as production manager in 1992. On November 4, 1952, Paul and Audrey Geraldine Warren were united in marriage at Holy Name Church. They enjoyed over 41 years together before her death on April 20, 1994.

Paul was a member of Christ the King Catholic Church where he served as an usher for many years. He was a member of Washburn Rural Optimists and volunteered for St. Francis Health Center, logging over 6,000 hours. He helped found the Ken Berry Baseball League and served on the original board. After taking a photography class, Paul photographed many of the city's sports teams as well as organizations' events for many years. He was an avid Kansas State Wildcat and St. Louis Cardinals fan.

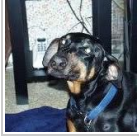
