Pauline Loretta Devlin, 87, Topeka, passed away Tuesday, August 6, 2013. Pauline was born November 1, 1925, in Manhattan KS, the daughter of George and Mabel Weisner. She attended Manhattan schools. At the age of 16, Pauline got her first job, driving a semi-truck at Fort Riley KS during WWII. She transported POWs to their job sites at the fort. Pauline and Henry Devlin married in Topeka.
