Pauline "Polly" Harris, 83, Topeka, passed away Sunday, February 5, 2017.

Polly was born January 22, 1934, in Warfield, Kentucky, the daughter of Mathew and Alice Hinkle Horn. She graduated from Warfield High School and then went to Washington D.C. to work for the Federal Bureau of Investigation. On March 12, 1955, Polly married George Harris in Arlington, Virginia. He preceded her in death on January 21, 2012. Polly also worked for Hallmark Cards in Topeka, Kansas and as director of food service at Brewster Place and McCrite Plaza for 20 years. Polly enjoyed cake decorating and was a member of a cake decorating club for many years. She was also a member of First Southern Baptist Church in Topeka and was a Den Mother for the Boy Scouts.

She is survived by two grandsons whom she raised, Casey Harris, Leavenworth and Jesse Harris, Topeka; and one sister, Eveline Jarrell of Orient OH. Polly was also preceded in death by her parents; her two sons, Terry and Randall Harris; eight brothers and one sister.
