



## Phyllis Moore

January 1, 1753 - July 30, 2010

Phyllis Moore, 86, formerly of Topeka, passed on Friday, July 30, 2010 in Peoria AZ. Born Phyllis Nickeson on Feb. 20, 1924, near Diller NE, she was the daughter of John and Carrie Thompson Nickeson, the third of eight children. She was employed in defense work during WWII, assembling ammo crates. Later she became an inspector for the ammo shells. During that time, on a train in Nebraska, she met a soldier on leave. That soldier was Lloyd V. "Blackie" Moore. They married on Nov. 20, 1945. From this union came five children, Steven V. Moore, Dana E. (Teresa) Moore, Jerold J. (Julie) Moore, Marcene M. Moore (deceased, 7/7/1979) and Richard D. (Sharon) Moore. Blackie passed on Dec. 12, 1995. Phyllis and Blackie owned and operated a night club in the mid 1950s at 10th and California, called the Yacht Club. Phyllis also operated the concession stand at Lake Shawnee for S.C.A.B.A. Baseball for several years in the 1970s. She was a member of Holy Name Catholic Church, Eagle's Lodge, American Legion Post 400 and was past president of the Ladies' Auxiliary. Phyllis was a true baseball Mom for a number of years and supported her husband and sons during their coaching and playing years. Survivors include her sons; ten grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren; brothers, Dwaine (Lois) Nickeson and John Nickeson; sister, Norma (Tom) Persson; in-laws, Carol Moore, Jim and Mary Moore, Cy and Jane Moore, all of NE, Paul and Clare Moore, Ames IA, and Bob and Margaret Sumner of St. Marys KS.
