November 11, 1927 - May 13, 2024

Ralph Wilford Stevens, 96, passed from this earth Monday, May 13, 2024, in Topeka, Kansas.

He was born on November 11, 1927, to Mark and Lottie (Wilson) Stevens in Joplin, Missouri.

Ralph graduated from Erie High School. After high school, he joined the Navy for two years, then later graduated from Washburn University in 1952. 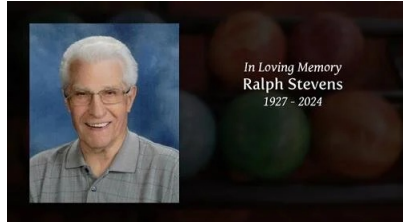
