



## Ramon Ramirez

March 12, 1940 - June 23, 2005

Ramon Ramirez, 65, Topeka, died Thursday, June 23, 2005, at the University of Kansas Medical Center.

Ramon was born March 12, 1940 in Kansas City, Kansas, the son of Ramon and Antonia Rivera Ramirez. He attended Riverview Grade School, Central Jr. High, Bishop Ward High School, and graduated from Donnelly and Rockhurst Colleges.
