



## Raymond Barnes

March 5, 1923 - September 11, 2008

Raymond (Chuck) Barnes, 85, passed away September 8, 2008 at Shawnee Mission Medical Center in Kansas City. A memorial service celebrating his life will be held on Thursday, September 11, 2008.
