March 24, 1916 - March 21, 2006

Raymond J. Ingenthron, 89, Topeka, passed away Tuesday, March 21, 2006 at Midland Hospice House.

Raymond was born in Topeka, on March 24, 1916, to the late Lawrence and Mary (Stramel) Ingenthron. Mr. Ingenthron served his country in the US Army during WWII. He was a prisoner of war for two years at Staleg 7A and was awarded two Purple Hearts.

Raymond married Dorothy Boner on Sept. 2, 1937. She passed away on Aug 5, 1995. He was a life member of the Elk Lodge 888 in Long Beach, CA. Raymond's career was in automobile sales. He moved back to Topeka in 1997.

Raymond was preceded in death by a brother, Harold Ingenthron, and a sister, Laurine Desch.

Survivors include six nieces and nephews, eight great-nieces and nephews, and six great-great-nieces and nephews.
