Richard Alfred “Ric” Barron, 72, Topeka Kansas, legendary musician, passed away Saturday, November 2, 2024.

Ric was born February 25, 1952, in Topeka, the son of Alfred and Juanita “Jennie” Mendoza Barron and attended Topeka High School. On January 8, 1994, Ric and Marta Hefner were united in marriage joining their lives together harmoniously for 30 years.

Following the Lord, Ric’s greatest love was his family, who are grateful to have shared his life: his dear wife Marta; children, Zebulin Barron, Abraham Barron, Micah Barron, Malisa Davis, Trey Jones (Bridgette), Clayton Senne; 18 grandchildren, 6 great-grandchildren; his mother, Juanita “Jennie” Barron; siblings, Ronaldo Barron (Judy), Roderick Barron, Raul Barron, and Regina Barron-Jaramillo; many aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his father, Alfred Barron.

Ric was lovingly known as “Papo” to his grandchildren and great-grandchildren with whom he shared unique relationships. Papo will be most remembered for sleepovers with pancakes, encouraging words and Scriptures, tight hugs, showing up for every event and making everyone laugh.

Ric was a profound presence in the music scene both locally and internationally. He and Marta won 1st Place in the International Christian Artist Music Awards for their duet. Ric was inducted into the Kansas Music Hall of Fame twice! He was the creative force behind Scatband and Scat Catz. He was a member of the Exceptions for 20 plus years and a part of numerous other bands as well.

Ric worked alongside his mother, Jennie, for years in Topeka's beloved Rosa's Mexican Restaurant and was the face of the business with his BIG personality, entertainment and joy. With his mother's retirement, Ric and Marta continued the legacy of Rosa's Mexican Restaurant until 2008.

Ric accomplished much as a musician and was dearly loved as a restaurateur but his first love was His Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. He was a devoted member of Lion & Lamb Church.

His love for his family was reflected in who Ric was. The Lord, Family and Music defined Ric. He loved fiercely and was deeply loved in return.

A Celebration of Ric's Life, a jam session to which all are invited, will be Sunday, December 1, from 4 to 8 p.m. at The Aurora at Vinewood.
