Richard Wayne Barta, 74, Topeka, Kansas, passed away at his home Wednesday, December 9, 2020.

Dick was born August 21, 1946, in Lucas, Kansas to Alvin and Loretta Novak Barta. He served our country as a radioman in the US Navy. On October 29, 1966, Dick and Marcia Cobb were united in marriage, enjoying 54 years together.

Dick was employed by the Kansas Highway Patrol for 29 years and served as Shawnee County Sheriff for 12 years. He was a member of Mother Teresa of Calcutta Catholic Church. Dick had a strong faith in God and was a devoted family man. He will be greatly missed.

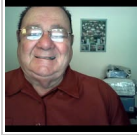
