Richard "Dick" Bell Richard "Dick" Wayne Bell, 58, Dover, passed away Mon., August 25, 2008, after battling pancreatic cancer for 27 months. Richard was born June 15, 1950 in Topeka, the son of Roscoe Leland and Mildred Lucile Webb Bell. He graduated from Dover High and attended Kansas State Teachers College in Emporia. On December 27, 1969 Richard and Debra Mitchell were married in Dover. Richard served our country in the Army National Guard, 169th Support Battalion of the 69th Brigade, from 1969 to 1975. He was a master electrician and worked for Amelco Electric and Western Extralite before going to Universal Mechanical and Electrical in 1990 where he developed the electrical department. He was a member of the Dover Community Foundation, Eagle Bus Club, Heritage Day Committees, Dover Ball Assoc., Dover Jaycees, Dover 4-H Clubs (as a member and a leader) and helped found the Native Stone Scenic Byway. Survivors include his wife, Debbie, of the home; sons, Michael Bell and Christopher Bell and his wife, Stacey; grandchildren, Branden, Ryan and Reese; siblings, Carol Standiford, Jacksonville Beach FL, Don Bell, Topeka and his twin, Robert Bell, Florahome Fl; and many nieces and nephews. An infant son, David Wayne Bell, preceded Richard in death. Family will greet friends from 6 to 8 p.m. Wed. at Dover Federated Church, Dover KS. Funeral service will be at 10 a.m. Thurs. at the church. Burial will follow in Dover Cemetery.
