Richard C. "Dick" Ray, 85, passed away May 31, 2013. He was born in Liberty, MO. He is preceded in death by his wife Corinne who passed away in 2008, just two weeks prior to their 60th wedding anniversary. Dick is survived by four children, seven grandchildren and four great grandchildren. Dick graduated from high school and attended Washburn University in Topeka. He was an Eagle Scout and he also served in the U.S. Navy 1945-1946. He retired from the Boy Scouts of America after having served for 43 years. Retiring in 1992 he moved to Tampa and began providing leadership to parish finances, Stephens Ministry, the Separated/Divorced group, organized the New Tampa Republican Club, co-chaired the organizing committee for St. Mark the Evangelist Catholic Church and later was the Coordinator of Stewardship at St. Mark's. He was a recipient of the St. George award by Bishop Sullivan of the Kansas City Diocese and the St. Jude the Apostle medal from Bishop Lynch of the St. Petersburg Diocese.
