Richard C. Hartman, 75, passed away Friday, Oct 1, 2010. Richard was born December 1, 1934 in Topeka the son of Joseph and Regina C. Mauer Hartman. He was a lifetime member of St. Joseph Catholic Church. Richard was a member of the Knights of Columbus since 1954 and the James W. Gibbons Assembly 286 Fourth Degree since 1967. Among other duties and positions, he served as Faithful Comptroller for 10 years, Faithful Navigator two years, assistant State Marshall for four years and was appointed State Marshall in 1970, a position he held for 32 years. Richard worked with his father in Shorty's Glass Service taking over the business on his father's retirement. He also worked for the Topeka Police Dept. Reserves and PSI Security. Survivors include his brothers, Don (Marilyn) Hartman and Larry (Sandy) Hartman; his sister, Margaret (John) Stattelmann; and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his two brothers, Jim and Bob Hartman. Richard will lie in state Mon. from 3 to 7 p.m. at St. Joseph Catholic Church, 227 SW Van Buren. Family will greet friends from 5 to 7 p.m. A parish rosary will be prayed at 5:30 p.m. The Knights of Columbus will honor Richard with a Fourth Degree Chalice Ceremony at 6:30 followed by a rosary. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Tues. at the Church. Burial will follow at Mt. Calvary Cemetery.
