Richard L. Jacobs, 77, passed away on Tuesday, May 20, 2014, as the result of a car accident. Dick was born on July 10, 1936, in Topeka to Joseph and Ada Zachariason Jacobs, who preceded him in death. In 1979 he was married to Carol Valus D'Andrea and together they raised her son, Marc D'Andrea (Lisa), Shawnee KS. He was previously married to Lois Hile Gragert and together they had three children, Russell Jacobs (Maejean), Topeka KS, Steven D. Jacobs (Monica), Topeka KS, and Cheryl Summers (Talbot), Deerfield Beech FL. Dick is survived by his wife and children, five grandchildren and five great-grandchildren as well as his sisters, Elaine Christian (Keith), Scotsdale AZ, Carolyn Bedell, Topeka KS, and Marlene Bien (Greg), Lawrence KS; his sister-in-law, Mary Zapala, Topeka KS; and a brother-in-law, Tom Valus, Bradenton FL.
