



Richard T. Waters, Jr.

September 20, 1937 - October 19, 2025

Richard Theodore Waters, Jr., 88, passed away peacefully at his home on Sunday, October 19, 2025. He was born on September 20, 1937, in Topeka, Kansas, to Richard T. Waters, Sr. and Louise Hazel Robinson.

Richard was a proud graduate of Topeka High School in the Class of 1955. As he studied to become a Court Reporter, Richard worked for Santa Fe Railroad for many years as a detailed box car builder. He went on to break barriers in his profession, becoming the first African American Court Reporter in the State of Kansas. He owned and operated Waters Court Reporting Service, a successful reporting practice for more than 40 years, serving the legal community with dedication, excellence, and integrity.

Richard was preceded in death by his second wife, Barbara Waters, born in Essex, England, with whom he shared 36 years of marriage. His first wife, Karon Lawton also preceded him in death, and he is survived by their children, Sheryl Renae Waters, Richard Waters III, and Kelly Waters; grandchildren, Couron Ray, Howard Bradley III, Ravyn Bradley, Michael Thommen, and Matthew Thommen; and great-grandchildren, Samuel Thommen, Couron Ray, Jr. and Layla Ray.

Richard also had three half-siblings, Gerald Revely, Merrell Revely, and Darrell Revely.

Richard will be lovingly remembered as a devoted family man, a great friend, a trailblazer in his field, and an exceptional businessman whose work ethic and determination inspired all who knew him.
