Richard Dean Wells, 71, Topeka, Kansas, died peacefully Friday morning, February 14, 2020, at a Topeka Nursing Home.

Mr. Wells served in the Navy following high school and was stationed in San Diego, California. After his military service, he went to work for Whelan's Lumber Company in Topeka and later started his own construction company. In December of 1986 he purchased Northbrook Lumber, Overbrook, Kansas. He was involved in construction for more than 30 years.

Survivors include his sons, Dane Wells (Melissa), Overbrook, and Daric Wells (Joni), Berryton; five grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.

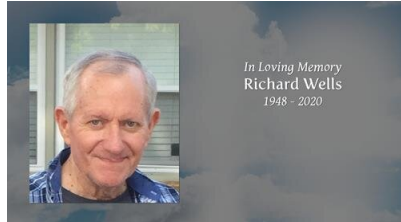
