Rita Boranyak Bates, 74, Topeka, passed away at Midland Hospice on Monday, April 6, 2026, after an extended illness.

Rita was born on January 7, 1952, in Topeka, Kansas, the daughter of Rudolph and Atha Rounkles Boranyak. Rita graduated from Hayden High School in 1970 and then attended Washburn University.

Rita married John Bates in 1973 at Most Pure Heart of Mary Catholic Church. John preceded Rita in death in 2018. John and Rita had a beloved daughter, Kelly Marie Bates, who passed away in 1982.

Rita was a devoted caregiver to Kelly during her illness, and later to John during his illness.

Rita was a special education professional for Topeka Unified School District 501 for 30 years, working at Highland Park North and Avondale West Elementary Schools. After retiring in 2017, Rita volunteered at Head Start.

Rita was loved and highly respected by her students and colleagues. In 2000, Rita received the Distinguished Staff Award, the highest honor USD 501 bestows on a staff member.

Rita and John were avid KU fans and members of the Jayhawk Club. They loved traveling, and their favorite destinations were Mexico and Carmel, California.

Rita had many friends. She enjoyed frequent lunches and outings with her friends from aqua exercise classes and with former Miller's Glen neighbors. She was a member of Christ the King Catholic Church.

Also preceding Rita in death were Rita's twin sister, Regina Faidley; nephew Brian Strong and her parents.

Rita is survived by her brother, Mark Boranyak (Sharon); sister, Terri Strong (Mark); nieces, Holly Busey (Matthew), Katie Faidley and Nikki Stiles (Chris); and many great nieces and nephews.

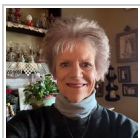
