March 26, 1918 - February 8, 2010

Rita (Reding) Fee, 91, Topeka, died Feb. 3, 2010 at a Topeka care community. Mrs. Fee was born March 26, 1918 in St. Marys KS, the daughter of Leo George and Mary Catherine Meyer Reding. She moved to Topeka in 1934. After graduating from Capital Catholic High School (now Hayden High School), she attended a telegraph school in Ft. Worth TX, after which she went to work for Western Union Telegraph for seven years. Mrs. Fee worked for Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas for 30 years until her retirement in 1978. She married Donald C. Fee on August 15, 1943 in Topeka. He preceded her in death on July 30, 2001. Survivors include numerous nieces and nephews. Cremation has taken place. Family will greet friends from 5 to 6 p.m. Monday at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Rd., Topeka, KS 66614 where a rosary will be prayed at 6 p.m. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Tuesday at Christ the King Catholic Church. Inurnment will take place at a later date at Stafford Cemetery, Stafford, KS.
