Robert E. Bellinder age 71, of Topeka, passed away Sun, May 28, 2007 at KU Med Center. Robert was born April 28, 1936, in Wamego, KS, the son of George and Elizabeth Fuhr Bellinder. Robert graduated from St. Mary's Catholic High School in 1954. He served in the Army as a SSgt for 2 years, and the National Guard for 33 years. Robert was a photographer for the US government. He married Shirley A. Vonfeldt April 20, 1963 in Topeka. She survives, as do numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by a brother James Bellinder and a sister Joann Cummings. Robert was a member of the American Legion Post #1, Christ the King Catholic Church, the Moose Lodge, and "The Photographers" study group. He was an accomplished photographer and artist. He loved to sketch people for their moods and facial expressions. He usually gave the subject the sketch to help brighten their day. Mr. Bellinder will lie in state after 2:00 p.m. with family receiving friends from 6-8 p.m. at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home where a parish rosary will be prayed at 7 p.m. Mass of Christian Burial will be 10 a.m., Fri, at Christ the King with burial at Mt. Calvary.
