Robert L. Carver, Jr., 55, Topeka, died suddenly on June 6, 2004 in Falls Church, Virginia.

Mr. Carver was born January 8, 1949 in Topeka, the son of Robert and Bernice Cross Carver, Sr. He attended Seaman High School graduating in 1967. Robert served in the U. S. Navy from 1970 to 1976. It was during this time in the Philippines that he met Merlinda Duran. They were married July 1, 1973. Mr. Carver earned a degree in Computer Science from Washburn University. He was a program manager for Northrup Grumman.
