March 23, 1927 - July 10, 2006

Robert M. (Bob) Keith, 79, Lawrence, KS (formerly Topeka, KS) passed away June 10, 2006 at home.

He was born March 23, 1927 in Ardmore, OK to Robert E. Cora Dyer Keith. He served in the Navy in 1945-1946. He graduated from the University of Oklahoma and Yale Medical School. His residency was in Oregon.

Dr. Keith practiced Psychiatry at the VA hospital in Topeka and later in private practice in Manhattan, KS.

Dr. Keith was a talented artist whose work has been exhibited at the Mulvane Art Museum, the Topeka Public Library and in the homes of friends and family. He never stopped learning and experiencing new things and was a friend to many.
