Robert Peter Meier, 94, Topeka, Kansas, passed away peacefully on Monday, May 20, 2024.

Bob was born in Topeka, the son of Joseph and Elizabeth Lambrecht Meier on December 13, 1929. He attended St. Joseph Grade School, graduated from Hayden High School in 1948 and spent two and a half years at Pontifical College Josephine Seminary. He served in the United States Army during the Korean War and was stationed in Germany. Following his military service, he became a civilian contractor with the United States Air Force and retired in 1984 working in the Pentagon. He married Charlotte Holland Meier on December 3, 1988; she preceded him in death on March 13, 2014. Bob was a member of Knights of Columbus Council #2608. He was an avid golfer and enjoyed entertaining his friends and family. Bob was greatly loved by all his many nieces and nephews.

Bob was also preceded in death by his parents, and his siblings, Casper, Marie Weigel, Joseph, Sylvester, Hubert, Augie, Lucile Krische, Pete, Leonard, and his twin brother, Raymond.
