Robert W. "Bob" Morrissey, 85, passed away Friday, Sept. 3, 2010 in West Plains, MO. Bob was born February 7, 1925 in Sutton, NE the son of John and Faye (Hawkins) Morrissey. After graduating from high school he moved to Seattle working the shipyards until he was old enough to join the military. He served as pilot in the US Army Air Corps from 1943 to 1946. From 1946 to 1949, he flew for the NE Air National Guard. His love of aviation continued throughout his life which included owning his own airplane. Bob married Kathleen Lohmeier on November 26, 1949 in Sutton, NE. Bob worked as the Divisional Administrator for the Federal Highway Department in Topeka from 1968 until his retirement in 1987. He is survived by 7 children, 18 grandchildren, 8 great grandchildren and a brother. He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Kathleen and son, Jim.
