Robert (Robbie) E. Kent died peacefully October 5, 2006 at Colmery O'Neil Hospital after a short illness. He was born May 2, 1948 in Norton KS, the son of Regina Best and Duane C. Kent. Robbie attended Holy Name Catholic School and graduated from Hayden High School in 1966. He attended Washburn University and worked as a land surveyor for many years in the state of Kansas. Some of his projects included Wolf Creek and Heartland Park. He served in the Armed Forces in Vietnam from 1967-1969, where he earned several medals, including the Bronze Star and Purple Heart. He received an honorable discharge in 1974. Robbie is survived by his longtime wife and companion, Ann Grimshaw Kent; a brother, Bill and sister Regina Kent of Oregon, Judith Kent of Colorado, Margaret Loehr of California, and many nieces and nephews.
