Rogelio "Roger" Isaac Ortega Sr., 60, Topeka, passed away February 6, 2016, at KU Medical Center.

Roger was born November 25, 1955, in Topeka, the third child of Isaac and Grace Chavez Ortega. He graduated from Topeka High School and was a proud graduate of three Citizens Academies: Topeka Police and Fire Departments and Shawnee County Sheriff's. Roger was a true musician who loved playing bass for the past 40 years with his brothers in the Paradize Band. He treasured the friendships with students and staff at Hayden Catholic High School where he proudly served as custodian the past 20 years. Roger loved sports and spent many years coaching baseball and basketball, was a loyal supporter of all of his children's activities, and was a diehard fan of the KU Jayhawks, KC Chiefs and Royals. His family requests that everyone attend his service wearing their favorite KU, Chiefs or Royals apparel.
