Rosemarie Rinner, 76, Topeka, died Sun., Sept. 25, 2005.

She was born December 3, 1928 in Beatrice, Nebraska to Henry and Anna Bestak Hurtig. Rosie was one of six children. She was preceded in death by her parents and four siblings, Margaret Loch, Henry Hurtig, Clare Peeso, and Eunice Hurtig.
