Rosemary Meinhardt Boston, 96, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Monday, April 1, 2024.

Rosemary was born April 18, 1927, in Paxico, Kansas, the daughter of Philip and Theresa Seeling Meinhardt and graduated from Paxico High School. She was employed for several years in the offices of International Harvester and Santa Fe Railroad.

On May 2, 1953, Rosemary and Robert Boston were married in Topeka enjoying more than 55 years prior to his death March 25, 2009. As the wife of an Army officer, Rosemary became adept at moving households as they were stationed at numerous bases in the U.S. and three cities in Germany.
