Roy D. Boley, 79, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Tuesday, August 22, 2017.

Roy was born July 30, 1938, in Topeka, the son of Harold and Harriet Luke Boley. He was a 1956 graduate of Topeka High School and attended Washburn University where he was a loyal member of Phi Delta Theta fraternity and was elected Greek Week King. Roy was a general agent for Transamerica Life Insurance Companies for 50 years and a lifetime member of the Million Dollar Round Table. 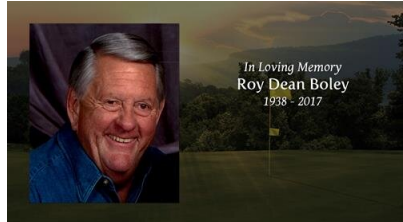
