Roy William Haines, Sr., 77, Topeka, died Tuesday, April 05, 2005.

Roy was born December 28, 1927 in Topeka, the son of Lester Leroy and Mary Ann Rendell Haines. He graduated from Washburn Rural High School and attended Washburn University. He retired from the State of Kansas, Dept. of Revenue in 1991. Roy was a member of Most Pure Heart of Mary Church. He played baseball for the Heart of America Semi-Pro Hardball Team. He was also an avid golfer, making a hole in one at Cedar Crest Country Club, and enjoyed fishing.
