

Rudolph "Rudy" Neugebauer

February 2, 1943 - April 5, 2023

Rudolph Lawrence "Rudy" Neugebauer, 80, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Wednesday, April 5, 2023.

Rudy was born February 2, 1943, in Kansas City, Missouri, and adopted March 5, 1943, by Herman and Bertha Hesse Neugebauer. He was baptized at St. Joseph Catholic Church and has been a life-long practicing Catholic. Rudy graduated from St. Joseph Grade School and Hayden High School in 1963, the first class in the "new" building on Gage Boulevard. Rudy's career was in restaurant food service, first at Hill and Dale Café, then Tevis' Restaurant for 18 years, Dilly's Café for two years and retired with 18 years of service at the Ramada Inn.

Rudy was a member of Sacred Heart-St. Joseph Parish, a life member of Third Degree Knights of Columbus, Council No. 4254 and a life member of the James W. Gibbons Fourth Degree Assembly and Color Guard.

Counted cross stitch, coloring and collecting Anheuser Busch Clydesdale beer steins were some of Rudy's hobbies but travel was his favorite. Florida and Disney World and various destinations in California offered wonderful experiences including helping to decorate Rose Parade floats.

Rudy is survived by his sister, Louise Neugebauer.

Visitation will be Thursday, April 13, from 9:30 a.m. until 10 a.m. at Sacred Heart Catholic Church. The Fourth Degree Chalice Ceremony will be at 10 a.m. at the Church followed by the rosary led by the Knights of Columbus. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Burial will be in Mount Calvary Cemetery.

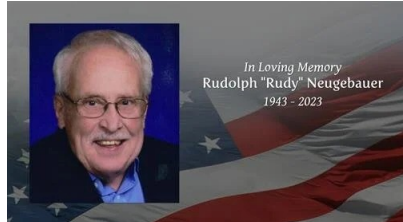
