Russell Woofter, 92, of Dover, died Wednesday, Sept. 5, 2007. He was born May 18, 1915 in Glenville, W. Va., the son of Earl and Dora (Messenger) Woofter. Russell was a member of the Dover Federated Church and served as a deacon and Sunday school teacher at the First Southern Baptist Church for many years. He enjoyed farming and raising cattle most of his life. He moved to Kansas from W. Va and lived in the Dover community since 1938. He married Marjorie Rogers on Jan. 22, 1941. She preceded him in death in July, 2006. He was also preceded in death by two sisters, Leola Woofter and Lena Woofter Bush, and by two brothers, Ollie and Avon Woofter. Survivors include two daughters Carol Crow (Alvin) and Arlena Jane Patterson (Jerry), all of Maple Hill; six grandchildren and fourteen great grandchildren. Russell will lie in state from 2 to 7:30 pm with a family visitation from 6 to 7:30 pm this evening at the Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW. Urish Rd, Topeka, KS 66614. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 pm Friday at the Dover Federated Church with burial to follow in the Dover Cemetery.
