Ruth Parry Alexander Stewart, 89, passed away November 2, 2006 in Phoenix, AZ. Ruth was born May 13, 1917 in Hanibal, MO the daughter of Charles E. and Frances Collins Parry. Ruth attended Topeka Catholic High School and Washburn University. She was a member of Kappa Alpha Theta Sorority. Ruth married John Alexander in 1937 and they moved to California.
