



Dr. Salvador T. Dipaling

January 1, 1935 - March 11, 2013

Salvador T. Dipaling, 77, of Topeka passed away, Mar. 6, 2013 at Midland Hospice. He was born Mar. 27, 1935 in Cotabato, Mindanao Philippines to Baldomero and Melanie (Tubojan) Dipaling. Salvador studied at Cotabato National High School. He got his pre-med degree at Silliman University in Dumaguarte, Negros Oriental, Philippines. He received his medical degree from Far Eastern University in Manila, Philippines in Dec. 1963. Salvador arrived in the U.S. in May of 1964 to intern at the McKay-Dee Hospital in Ogden UT. Salvador did three years of residency in the field of pathology at St. Francis Hospital in Wichita KS. During this residency Salvador married Margene Braddy in 1968 at St. Michaels in Mulvane KS. She survives. He finished his residency in pathology at Mt. Sinai Hospital in Chicago IL in 1971. Salvador did a fellowship in OB-GYN pathology at Magee Women's hospital from June 1971 until June 1972. He set up the Department of Nuclear Medicine at the Colmery-O'Neil VA Hospital in Topeka where he was administrator of the department for 25 years up until his retirement in 1997. Salvador was a member of Christ the King parish. He enjoyed playing golf and watching sporting events. Survivors include his wife of 44 years, Margene Dipaling; two sons, S.Robert Dipaling and Jeffrey Dipaling, of Topeka; sister, Cora Coates, Ogden UT; and many loving nieces and nephews in the Philippines and U.S. He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers and two sisters. Funeral service will be 11:00 a.m. Mon, Mar. 11, 2013 at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Rd., Topeka KS. In lieu
