The story of Sarah Ann Madl began February 21, 1988 in Topeka KS. It should have been a long novel with each day a page and each year a chapter. But her story was cut short by a villain named colorectal cancer. Sarah is the daughter of Tom and Marsha Powell Madl. She attended Randolph Elementary, Robinson Middle School and graduated from Topeka High School where she was involved in the band, theater and tennis. Sarah was a senior at Washburn University, studying to be a librarian, a member of Sigma Alpha Iota Sorority and played in the WU Marching Band. Sarah loved books, music, coffee and, the love of her life, Will Arasmith, who was a constant source of strength and happiness to her. Sarah was a delight who was known to be an "old soul". This chapter of Sarah's earthly story ended on Sunday, February 13, 2011. Survivors include her parents, Tom and Marsha; brother, Adam Madl (Jeong Hee); sister, Mary Madl, Overland Park; and aunts, uncles and cousins. She was preceded in death by her grandparents, Jack and Alice Powell and Donald and Annabel Madl. Sarah will lie in state from 5 to 8 p.m. Tues. at Mater Dei Holy Name Church, where family will greet friends from 6 to 8 p.m. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Wed. at the church.
