Elaine “Sherry” Carol Hiszczynskyj, 66, of Topeka, Kansas passed away April 12, 2007 in a motor vehicle accident near Lamoni, Iowa. She was born February 14, 1941 in Mason City, Iowa. She was the daughter of Phillip Johnson Sheridan and Carol Elaine Sheridan. She graduated in 1959 from Saint Joseph High School in Mason City, Iowa where she enjoyed playing the string bass and percussion. Sherry was a graduate of Mason City Junior College. She graduated from Saint Anthony Hospital School of Medical Technology, in Rockford, Illinois. She also graduated from the University of Iowa with a Bachelor of Science in Medical Technology. She worked as a Medical Laboratory Technologist for the University of Iowa Medical Center in Iowa City, where she met her husband. Sherry married Dr. Roman Hiszczynskyj on September 11, 1965. Sherry was a loving wife, mother and grandmother; a caring daughter and sister; and a kind and generous friend. She was an active parishioner of Christ the King Catholic Church in Topeka, Kansas.
