Shirley (Linnemann) Buhrman, 89, went to be with our Lord on Friday, December 27, 2024, in Topeka, Kansas. She was born March 25, 1935, in Grand Island, Nebraska to Elmer and Helen Linnemann. She was an only child.

Shirley attended Grand Island Senior Highschool where she was active in clubs and a majorette for the high school band.
