Shirley Marie Willis, beloved wife and mother, passed away on August 22, 2025. Shirley was born on July 22, 1936, in Beatrice, Nebraska. She was raised in Washington, Kansas and graduated from Washington High School in 1954. Shirley then graduated from cosmetology school and worked as a hairdresser in Emporia and Topeka, Kansas. It was while she was working in Emporia that she met her husband, Russ. They were married at Sacred Heart Parish in Emporia on August 19, 1961, celebrating 52 years of marriage. Russ preceded her in death on December 29, 2014.

Shirley adored and deeply loved her girls and Russ dedicating her life to creating a loving and nurturing home. She was blessed with many creative talents and always placed her family first with an unwavering love. Shirley was a lifelong Catholic who was deeply devoted to God, the Blessed Mother and led a life of faithfulness. When faced with ongoing health challenges, Shirley had remarkable strength and courage, never complaining or questioning. She faced these challenges with grace and bravery.

Shirley loved working out in the yard with Russ and found pleasure in creating beautiful flower beds. Shirley was a member of Most Pure Heart of Mary Parish for 63 years participating in Let's Help, was a previous member of Women's Fellowship and was a committed eucharistic adorer for 28 years.

Shirley is survived by her daughters Cathy and Tracy. She is also survived by her sister Bea Martel and several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband, Russ, her parents Anthony and Hilda Wetter, and her brother Lester Wetter.
