Socorro (Cora) V. Gonzales, 88, Topeka passed away Thurs., Feb. 4, 2010. Mrs. Gonzales was born June 27, 1921 in Horton KS, the daughter of Felix Vallejo and Celerina Lopez. She attended parochial and public schools and graduated from Horton High School in 1940. She then moved to Argentine KS and worked there until she met and married her husband, Joe T.
